

JAOSACCION (CHLOROPHYCEAE, ULOTRICHALES),
A NOMENCLATURAL CHANGE

Recently, I transferred *Ectochaete endophytum* to *Coelodiscus* Jao (van den Hoek, 1965). Dr. R. C. Bakhuizen van den Brink (Rijksherbarium, Leiden), however, drew my attention to the fact that *Coelodiscus* Jao (1941) is a later homonym of *Coelodiscus* Baillon (1858).

The new generic name *Jaosaccion* is therefore proposed for the ulotrichalean species so far ranged under *Coelodiscus* Jao.

Jaosaccion v. d. Hoek, *nov. nom.* — *Coelodiscus* Jao, 1941. — *non Coelodiscus* Baillon, 1858, p. 293—294.

Jaosaccion prasinum (Jao) v. d. Hoek *nov. comb.* — *Coelodiscus prasinus* Jao, 1941.

Jaosaccion endophytum (Möbius) v. d. Hoek *nov. comb.* — *Bulbocoleon endophytum* Möbius, 1891, p. 1292—1293. — *Coelodiscus endophytus* (Möbius) v. d. Hoek, 1965.

No new combination is proposed for *Coelodiscus bullatus* Jao (1947), since that species probably is a synonym of *Jaosaccion prasinum*.
