

SOME NEW RECORDS OF LYSIMACHIA IN INDO-MALESIA  
(PRIMULACEAE)

The examination of the material of *Lysimachia* of Herbarium Bogoriense and unidentified material from the Michigan Herbarium at Ann Arbor which came too late into my hands for inclusion in my revision in *Flora Malesiana*, vol. 6 (1962) 177—186, yielded some new records and localities worth mentioning.

**Lysimachia capillipes** Hemsl. *J. Linn. Soc. Bot.* 26 (1889) 48; Bentv. *Fl. Mal.* I, 6 (1962) 179, fig. 4 (map).

ASSAM. Khasi Hills, Cherrapunjee, in forest, 1200 m, *W. N. Koelz* 29705 (Mich), 6-5-1952.

Not yet recorded west of Yunnan.

**Lysimachia decurrents** Forst. *f. Prod.* (1786) 12; Bentv. *Fl. Mal.* I, 6 (1962) 185, fig. 10 (map).

CELEBES. S. W. Central part, west slope Latimodjong Ra., Rante Lemo, in fields, 1100 m, *G. Kjellberg* 1426 (Bo, L).

Not yet recorded for Celebes.

**Lysimachia mauritiana** Lamk. *Encycl.* 3 (1791) 572; Bentv. *Fl. Mal.* I, 6 (1962) 183, fig. 9 (map).

PHILIPPINES. Babuyanes, Camiguin I., Mt Napolapola, *G. Edaño* BS 79370 (Bo, L), April 1930.

In the Philippines as yet only recorded from the Batan Is.
