

JAOA AND JAOSACCION (CHLOROPHYCEAE, ULOTRICHALES)

Recently I (Van den Hoek, 1966) proposed the new name *Jaosaccion* for the chlorophycean genus *Coelodiscus* Jao (1941), which is a later homonym of *Coelodiscus* Baillon (1858).

Jaosaccion, in its turn, appears to be a synonym of *Jaoa* Fan (1964).

Jaoa Fan, 1964. — *Coelodiscus* Jao, 1941. — *non Coelodiscus* Baillon, 1858. — *Jaosaccion* v. d. Hoek, 1966.

Jaoa prasina (Jao) Fan, 1964. — *Coelodiscus prasinus* Jao, 1941. — *Jaosaccion prasinum* (Jao) v. d. Hoek, 1966.

Jaoa endophyta (Möbius) v. d. Hoek, nov. comb. — *Bulbocoleon endophytum* Möbius, 1891. — *Coelodiscus endophytus* (Möbius) v. d. Hoek, 1965. — *Jaosaccion endophytum* (Möbius) v. d. Hoek, 1966.
