Important: reports should have the following format:

Family name, full name of taxon (incl. all authors), rough locality, date of collection, collector's name and collection number, place(s) of deposit, previously known distribution, additional remarks, authority for the report. In a footnote the Foundation(s) from which grants were received may be mentioned. For examples see below.

The Editors of the Bulletin disclaim any responsibility for possible misidentifications or superfluous records, these should be accredited to the correspondents who have reported them. We will moreover decide whether we will include a record or not depending on their significance as we see it. For the future the exact criteria for inclusion will be formulated after some experience with the subject.

Aglaomorpha latipinna (C. Chr.) Roos. New for New Guinea: Irian Jaya, Valentijns Mts, 1988, N. of Angguruk Village, 28 August 1988, Mangen 2230 (L). Also known from Celebes. (P.H. HOVENKAMP).

ANGIOSPERMS

Anacardiaceae

Melanochyla borneensis (Ridl.) Ding Hou. New for Kalimantan: Gunung Pa Nature Reserve, 1985, M. Leighton 1597 (L). Previously known from Sarawak.*

Burseraceae

Protium connarifolium (Perk.) Merr. New for Luzon: Mt. Malinaoc, 9 April 1987, Burley 105 (L). Previously known from Palawan.*

Celastraceae

Microtropis kinabaluensis Merr. & Freem. New for Kalimantan: Gunung Pa Nature Reserve, 13 June 1986, van Balgooy & Setten 5418 (L). Previously known from Sabah.*

Euphorbiaceae

Croton ensifolius Merr. New for Kalimantan: Danau Sentarum, July 1986, Giesen 81 (L). Previously known from Malaya, Sarawak, Sabah, and New Guinea.*

Gramineae

Alloteropsis cimicina (L.) Stapf. New for New Guinea: Madang Prov., Usino-Ramu River, 24 August 1987, Goetghebeur & Vyverman 6128 (GENT, L); Usino-Bundi, 6 September 1987, Goetghebeur & Vyverman 6321 (GENT, L). Previously known from tropical E. Africa to N. Australia, in Malesia from Malaya, Sumatra, Java, Borneo, Timor.

Chionachne javanica (Henr.) Clayton. Genus and species new for Flores: Nunang, 700 m, 1 June 1984, Schmutz 6051 (L). A very rare species, previously only known from the type locality in Java (Besuki, Puger, G. Watangan, 25 m) and from Alor (Pisigomo, Lantoka, 650 m, 12 May 1938, Jaag 993, L, Z). Presumably calcicolous.

Digitaria ternata (A. Rich.) Stapf. New for Irian Jaya: Sentani, 18 March 1973, Raynal 16654 (BR, L, P). Previously known from the Old World tropics.

Ehrharta stipoides Labill. New for Mt. Pulog, Philippines: 15 October 1975, L.L. Co 1399 (L, PNH). Formerly known in Luzon from Mt. Data, Mt. St. Tomas, Mt. Tonglon, elsewhere in Java, Timor, New Guinea, Australia, New Zealand.

Eriachne burkittii Jansen var. burkittii. New for Indonesia: Irian Jaya, Sentani, 23 March 1973, Raynal 16784 (BR, L, P). Previously known from the W. Province, Papua New Guinea and the Northern Territory, Australia.

Garnotia acutigluma (Steud.) Ohwi. New for Ceram: Manusela National Park, 140–630 m, 30 December 1984, Ueda et al. C-2894. Previously known from Indochina to S. China, widely spread in Malesia, in the Moluccas known from Ambon, Ternate.

Isachne myosotis Nees. New for the Moluccas: Tidore, summit of G. Kiematuba, 7 August 1954, Alston 16729 (L, BM, BO); Ceram, Manusela National Park, 1080–1130 m, 24 January 1985, Kato et al. C-5877 (L, BO, TI). Widely spread in Malesia, also occurring in the Ryukyus and Taiwan.

Juglandaceae

Engelhardia rigida Bl. New for Buru: November 1984, Nooteboom 5142 (L). Previously known from Borneo to New Guinea, in the Moluccas only known from Halmaheira and Morotai.*

Orchidaceae

Cleisostoma scortechinii (Hook. f.) Garay. New for Java, W: Cihurip, 600 m, photo only. Previously known from Thailand, Sumatra, Malaya, Borneo. (J.B. COMBER).

Dendrobium aegle Ridl. (incl. D. inopinatum J.J. Sm.). New for Java, W: G. Halimun, 950 m, 19 January 1986, Comber 1632 (K). Previously known from Thailand, Malaya, Sumatra. (J.B. COMBER).

Dendrobium eriiflorum Griff. New for Java, E. G. Arjuno, G. Kelud, G. Tengger, 1000-1520 m, 2 April 1979, Comber 1055 (K). Previously known from India, Burma, Malaya, Sumbawa. (J.B. COMBER).

Dendrobium malvicolor Ridl. New for Java, E. G. Lawu, G. Tengger, 1590-1980 m, Comber 1074 (K). Previously known from Sumatra. (J. B. COMBER).

Dendrobium sanguinolentum Lindl. New for Java, W: near Cihurip, 800 m, photo only. Previously known from Thailand, Sumatra, Malaya, Borneo. (J.B. COMBER).

Eulophia graminea Lindl. New for Java, W: outskirts of Jakarta, sea level, photo only. Previously known from India to Taiwan. (J.B. COMBER).

Flickingeria nativitatis (Ridl.) J.J. Wood. New for Java, E: Southern slopes of G. Lamongan, 500 m, 27 January 1984, Comber 1591 (K). Previously known from Christmas Island, Indian Ocean. (J.B. COMBER).

Octarrhena condensata (Ridl.) Holtt. New for Java, W: G. Halimun, 1100 m, 24 August 1986, Comber 1652 (K). Previously known from Malaya, Sumatra. (J. B. COMBER).

Thrixspermum tortum J.J. Sm. New for Java. E: Southern slopes of G. Lamongan, 520 m. 13 March 1981, Comber 1223 (K). Previously known from Sumatra, Borneo. (J.B. COMBER).

Rosaceae

Prunus wallaceana Kalkm. New for Buru: November 1984, Mogea 5235 (BO, L). Endemic to the Moluccas and Lesser Sunda Islands.*

Sapindaceae

Alectryon glaber Radlk. New for the Moluccas: Ceram, 8 km S of Bula, 50 m, 28 February 1985, Kato et al. C-8287 (L, BO, TI). Previously known from E. Java, the Lesser Sunda Islands, Celebes, Philippines, and the Kai Islands. (P. W. LEENHOUTS).

Ulmaceae

Aphananthe philippinensis Planch. New for the Moluccas: Buru, 3 December 1984, van Balgooy 5041 (L). Previously known from Australia, New Guinea, Philippines.*
