

VII. DATES OF PUBLICATION AND BIBLIOGRAPHICAL NOTES

Annales des Sciences Naturelles, Sér. 5, Botanique.

From the dates reproduced it is seen that part 1 was billed in November 1868; it is assumed that this puts the publication date of the whole volume after that of vol. 1 of 'The Flora of Tropical Africa'.

Forster, J. R. & Forster, J. G. A., Characteres generum plantarum, etc. 1st ed. 1775. Folio.

The well-known quarto edition 1776 has been found to have been issued on March 1, 1776; another edition, also dated 1776, was printed in long folio format, and seems to have existed of 8 copies (elsewhere recorded 25 copies). Actually these were 2nd editions.

A first folio edition was published between Nov. 29 and Dec. 2, 1775, in 6 copies, of which 2 could be retraced. The first in the British Museum (originally presented to King

George III), the second in the Library of the Linnean Society London (originally presented to Linnaeus).

A list of the new genera and species thus described actually in 1775 is given with their evaluation.

The dating has no nomenclatural consequences, except that *Baeobotrys* Forst. is now a legal synonym of *Maesa* Forst.

As the numbers of all fascicles have not yet been ascertained with certainty, it seems worthwhile to record that in above-mentioned letter was stated that fasc. 6 (the last one) was ready and would be sent in about 6 weeks.

R o x b u r g h, W., Plants of the coast of Coromandel, etc.

Up till now the month of publication of the 11th and 12th (final) parts were recorded to have been published either in Febr. or March 1820. Dr. J. Bastin was so kind to inform me that they were printed and distributed by 18 February 1820 (viz a letter of .. Nicol to Joseph Dart, dated Pall Mall, 18-2-1820, sending the concerned numbers; MSS. Eur. F.25, India Office Library, fol. 305).
