At the 131st anniversary of the Botanic Gardens, Buitenzorg, the following botanists have been elected as honorary collaborators of the Gardens: Prof.Dr A. E r n s t (Zürich), Dr D. After August 1, 1948, Dr Reed C. C ollins will be director of the Gray Herbarium; the acting director, Dr Lincoln C on stance, is returning to his permanent position at the Univ. of California.

Dr N.L.B o r, of the Indian Forest Serveice (retired), has been appointed Deputy director at the Royal Bot.Gardens, Kew. Dr A.A.P u l l e, Director of the Botanical Museum & Herbarium and Professor in the University at Utrecht reached the age of 70 on Jan. 10th.
