

XI. NEW RECORDS

The reasons for this new chapter have been given in the Editorial. No undescribed taxa will be accepted, these should be published elsewhere, as the Flora Malesiana Bulletin is not to be regarded as an effective publication in the nomenclatural sense. The list, moreover, would be too long and the work to extract them from the vast literature too burdensome. Such information will be mentioned, as before, in the chapter on Progress or in the Bibliography.

**Important:** reports should have the following format:

Family name, full name of taxon (incl. all authors), rough locality, date of collection, collector's name and collection number, place(s) of deposit, previously known distribution, additional remarks, authority for the report. In a footnote the Foundation(s) from which grants were received may be mentioned. For examples see below (but not those marked <sup>6</sup>)).

- The editors of the Bulletin disclaim any responsibility for possible misidentifications or superfluous records, these should be accredited to the correspondents who have reported them. We will moreover decide whether we will include a record or not depending on their significance as we see it. For the future the exact criteria for inclusion will be formulated after some experience with the subject.
