Sent at least 11 specimens to BO, e.g. no. 11 Panicum luzonense from 7 km South of Parungpanjang, Java, collected on 28 October 1943 ('2603').

CAULFIELDS, F.M.G.

Collected a Cinnamomum velutinum in Upper Perak for the Perak Museum Herbarium, now in SING.

CIVIEL GEZAGHEBBER TALIWANG.

Sent at least 4 specimens to BO, e.g. no. 4 Panicum caudiglume from R. Daramisae, Taliwang, Sumbawa, collected on 31 May 1918.

KUDO, Mrs. Y. (Setagaya, Tokyo) and Mr. S. KOIZUMI (Honjo, Saitama Pref., Japan)

Donated some 200 specimens of Pteridophytes collected in Lombok and Bali, incl. Onychium siliculosum, Pyrrosia longifolia to TNS (TNS Times 15, 1986, 60).
