Several suggestions have been made to improve our overview of the remaining taxonomic work, e.g. a fact sheet showing the families and genera not-allotted as yet. Roos will update and expand the list given in Flora Malesiana Bulletin 11, p. 138–142. Another important item on the agenda was fund raising. Hay and Mabberley have brought about ideas to develop new strategies to obtain additional funding for FM revisions. The Board applauded their initiative and invited them to continue. They will report in the next issue of the Bulletin.

The next Flora Malesiana Symposium in Malaysia was also discussed. It was stressed to include in the programme family workshops to be organized by the coordinating authors and especially aimed to bring together Malesian botanists.
