Author of A checklist of vascular plants of Bougainville (Bot. Bull., Lae 5, 1971); elaborated the Corynocarpaceae and Myristicaceae for the Handbooks of the Flora of New Guinea 1 (1978) 111—113, 175—215, resp.; made a taxonomic study of Helicia for his Ph.D.
